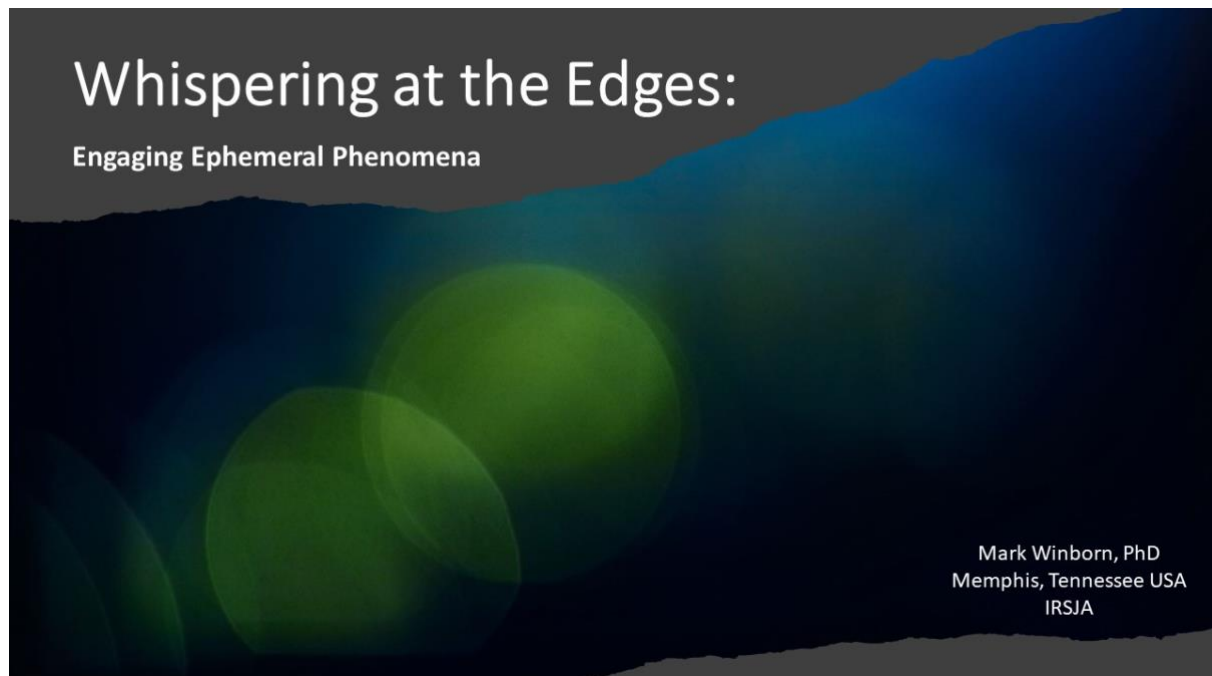

Engaging Ephemeral Phenomena***

In this seminar **Dr Mark Winborn** will address the analyst's capacity to recognize and engage ephemeral phenomena in the analytic setting as an essential pillar of deep analytic

engagement. It proposes that the analyst's capacity to engage the ephemeral is an ongoing developmental progression which complements and deepens the other areas of analytic knowledge acquired during analytic training such as theory, technique, archetypal patterns, psychopathology and development. The presentation provides a working definition of the ephemeral and focuses on the phenomenological experience of the ephemeral. It also discusses the use of reverie in ephemeral engagement and the use of poetry to develop the analyst's sensitivity and responsiveness to ephemeral moments.

PRESENTER:

Mark Winborn, PhD, NCPsA is a Jungian Psychoanalyst and Clinical Psychologist. He received his BS in Psychology from Michigan State University in 1982, his MS and PhD in Clinical Psychology from the University of Memphis in 1987, and his certificate in Jungian Analysis from the Inter-Regional Society of Jungian Analysts in 1999. From 1988 – 1990 he was the staff psychologist at the United States Military Academy, West Point, New York. Dr. Winborn is a training/supervising analyst of the Inter-Regional Society of Jungian Analysts, the C.G. Jung Institute in Zurich, Switzerland, the Moscow Association for Analytical Psychology, and the Romanian Society for Jungian Analysts. He served on the American Board for Accreditation in Psychoanalysis for nine years and the Ethics Committee of the International Association for Analytical Psychology for six years. Dr. Winborn is on the editorial boards of the *Journal of Analytical Psychology* and the *Journal of Humanistic Psychology*, as well as being a member of the National Association for the Advancement of Psychoanalysis.

His publications include *Deep Blues: Human Soundscapes for the Archetypal Journey* (2011) and *Shared Realities: Participation Mystique and Beyond* (2014), and *Interpretation in Jungian Analysis: Art and Technique* (2018), as well as a variety of journal articles, chapter contributions, and book reviews. Additionally, he has two books forthcoming from Routledge in 2023 - *Beyond Persona: Jungian Analysts on Individuation and Beginnings* (with Lavinia Țânculescu-Popa) and *Jungian Psychoanalysis: A Contemporary Introduction* (part of the Routledge series *Introductions to Contemporary Psychoanalysis*). He has also presented papers at the past five Congresses of the International Association for Analytical Psychology (Montreal 2010, Copenhagen 2013, Kyoto 2016, Vienna 2019, Buenos Aires 2022). Since

1990 he has maintained a private practice in Memphis, Tennessee, USA where he was the Training Coordinator for the Memphis-Atlanta Jungian Seminar from 2010 - 2016.
