

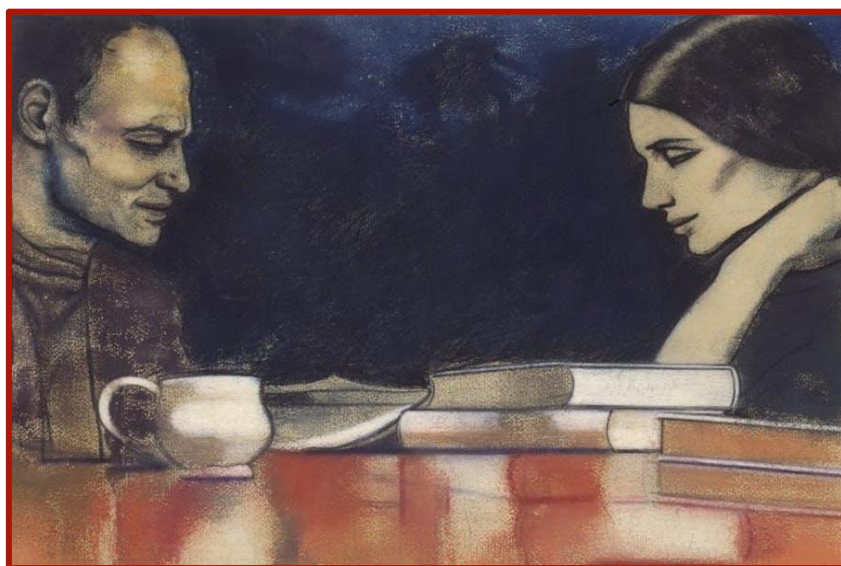

In 2019 ANZSJA’s Professional Development Programme is offering reading groups for mental health professionals interested in reading and thinking about Jungian and post-Jungian approaches to psychotherapy and analysis in the context of their own developing clinical practice. Different Jungian analysts will facilitate reading groups in their consulting rooms beginning in February 2019. Some analysts will offer Skype / Zoom / FaceTime participation. The groups will begin with some background readings and selected readings from Jung’s Collected Works. These are a springboard from which facilitators and their groups will determine further readings based on their own interests. Meetings may be weekly, fortnightly or monthly, determined by the analyst.
