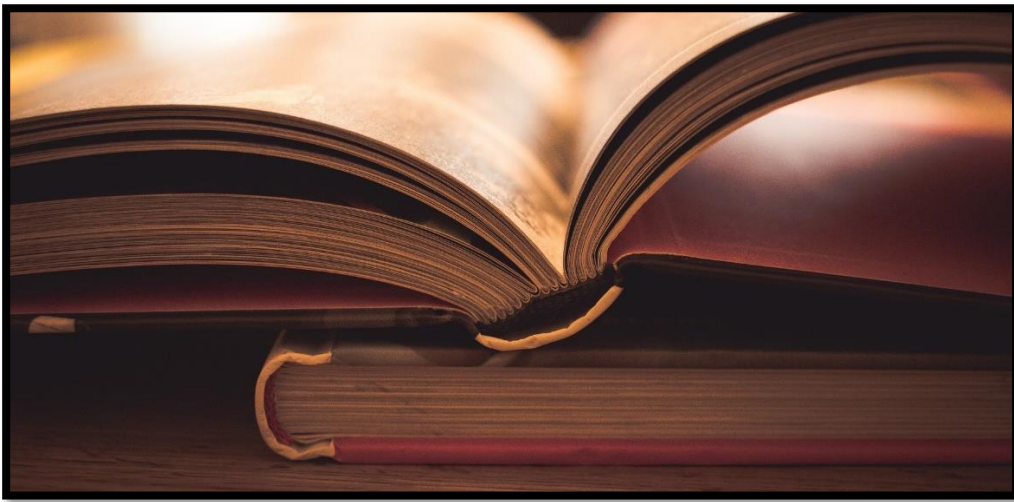

In 2020 ANZSJA’s Professional Development Programme is continuing to offer reading groups for mental health professionals interested in reading and thinking about Jungian and post-Jungian approaches to psychotherapy and analysis in the context of their own developing clinical practice. Different Jungian analysts will facilitate reading groups in their consulting rooms. Some analysts will offer Skype / Zoom / FaceTime participation.

There are different categories of groups. Existing groups will continue along the trajectory that they have established according to the participants interests and preoccupations. New groups will begin with some background readings and selected readings from Jung’s Collected Works. These texts are a springboard from which facilitators and their groups will determine further readings based on their own interests. There are several theme-based reading groups.
